If you strive to achieve the CASP certification you will have to have a minimum off 10 years' experience that includes up to five years of hands-on technical security experience.

## **Prerequisites:**

While there are no strict prerequisites, CompTIA intends the CASP certification to serve as an add-on to the CompTIA® Security+® certification, or equivalent technical experience.
